The OHF Bursary Program

REWARDING DEDICATION IN EDUCATION AND HOCKEY

The Ontario Hockey Federation (OHF) is a branch of Hockey Canada with over 250,000 registered participants. The OHF Bursary Program provides financial assistance to registered participants to help offset the cost of post secondary education. The Program has awarded over \$180,000 in 13 years. Recipients are not eligible in subsequent years. The number of recipients and the amount awarded to each will be determined by the OHF Bursary Committee.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible to receive a bursary, a candidate must meet the following criteria:

- Be registered for three (3) years within the OHF in any capacity.
- Have registered with the OHF during his/her application season.
- Be a registrant in good standing with the OHF.
- Be enrolling or enrolled in a recognized post-secondary institution in Canada.
- Meet the admission standards of the post-secondary institution that he/she will be attending.
- Have maintained clear academic status. Students on probation are not eligible for a bursary.

HOW TO APPLY

1. All candidates must complete the application form included in this brochure.
2. Accompanying the application form, a candidate must submit all required documents.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- A letter from the candidate outlining his/her contributions to hockey, what the game of hockey has meant to him/her and other information such as volunteer/community involvements.
- Two (2) letters of reference from his/her current school on official school letterhead.
- One (1) letter of reference from a hockey-related organization on official letterhead.
- Most current copy of his/her Official School Transcript.
- A copy of his/her current marks summary.

Note: 40% of total score will be for school related submissions while the remaining 60% of the total score will come from personal contribution to hockey and the community.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

All documents must be one-sided, unstapled, unbound, and placed in the order listed above.

Please be advised that incomplete applications will not be considered and facsimiles will not be accepted. Applicants who submit incomplete and/or ineligible applications will not be contacted.

All required information must be received in the OHF office by 4:30 p.m. on April 30, 2010. Applications should be sent to the following address:

The OHF will announce successful applicants no later than September 2010 and payment of the bursary will be made in November 2010 upon receiving proof of enrollment. Proof of enrollment must be in the form of official documents (i.e. letter from registrar) from the educational institution the recipient is attending. Payment will be made directly to the recipient.
